- Adult supervision required

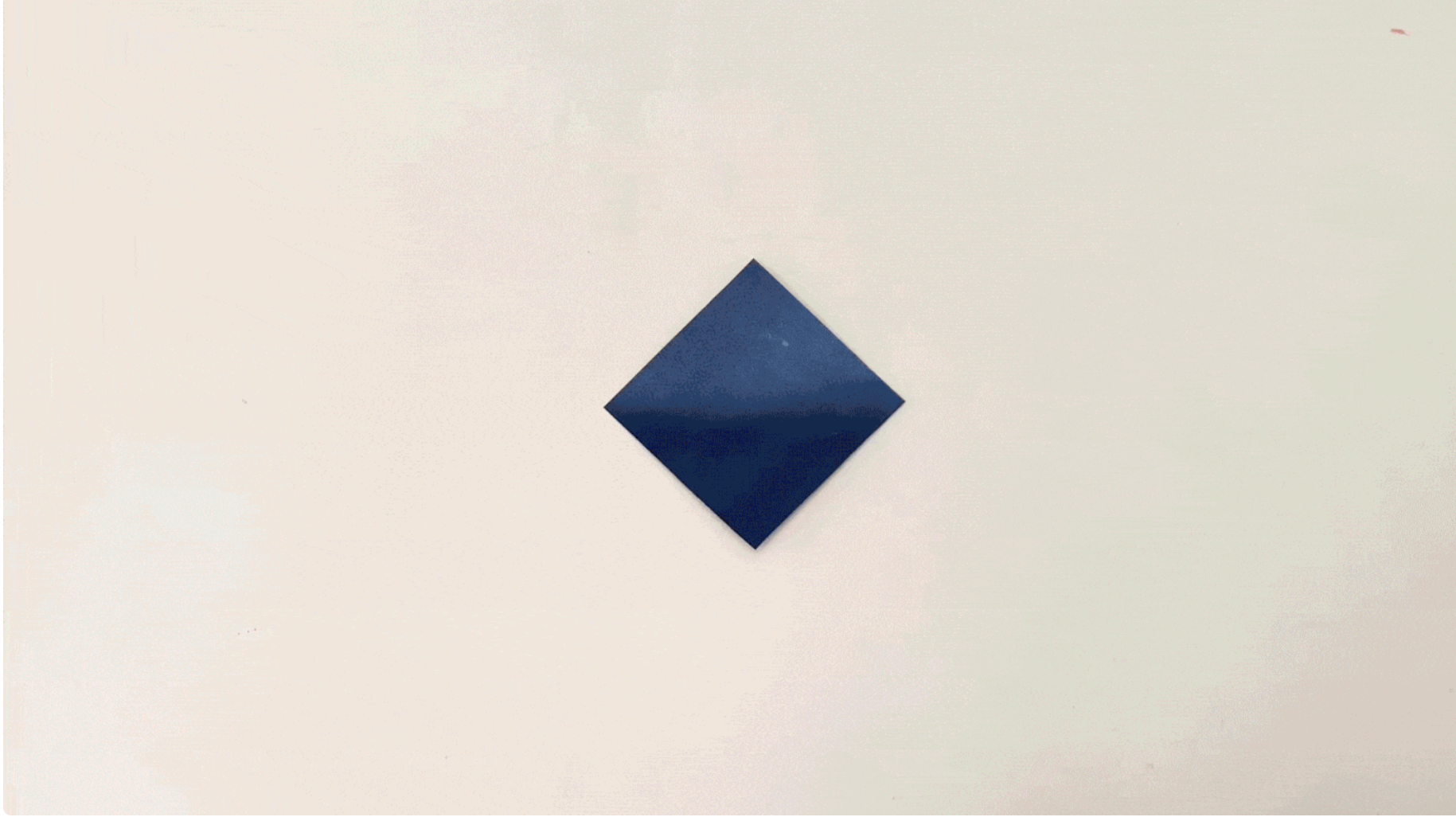
## Materials Needed:

Coloured Cardstock  
Scissors  
Glue  
Googly Eyes

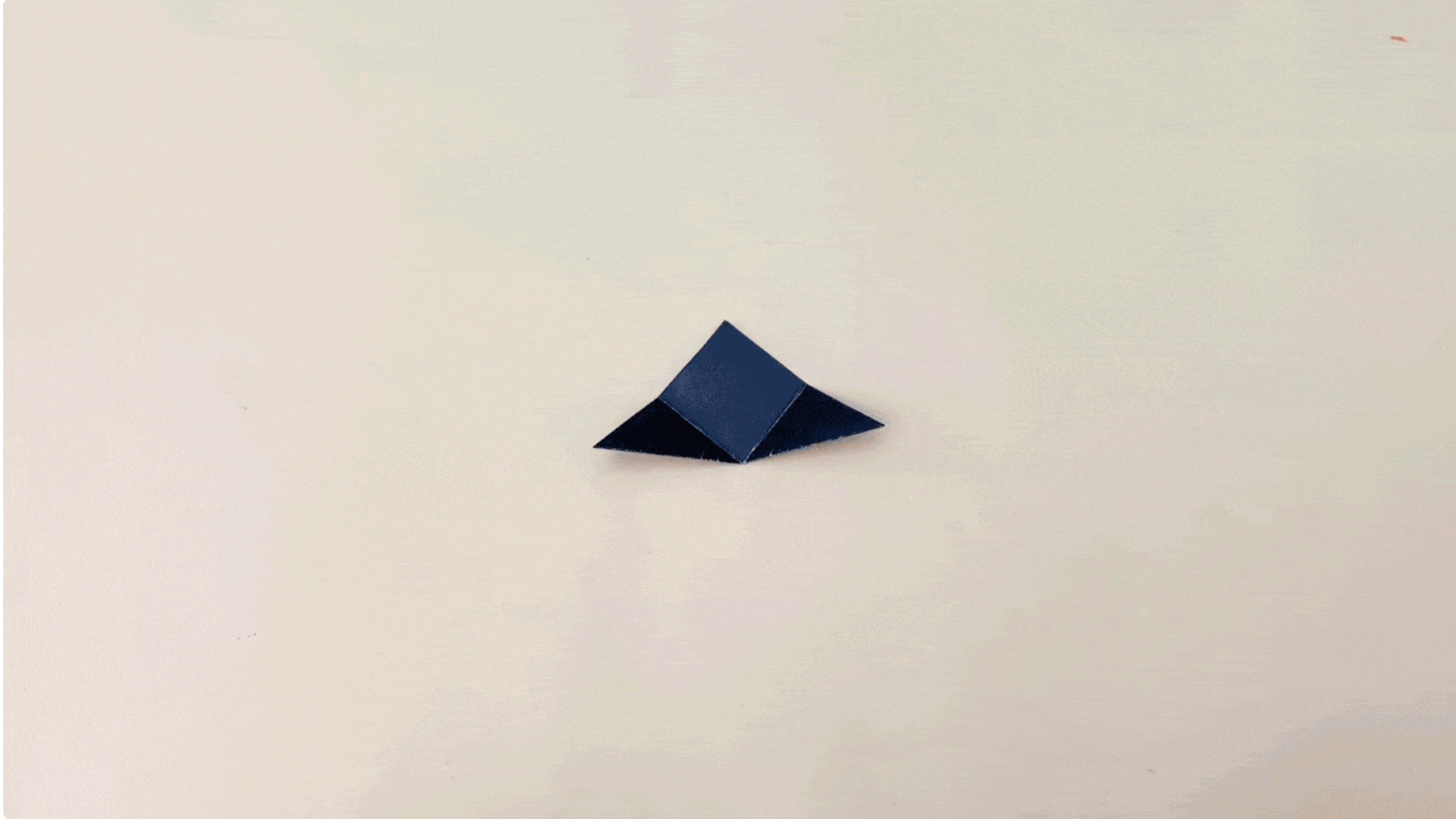


## Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Fold the paper diagonally to form a triangle.



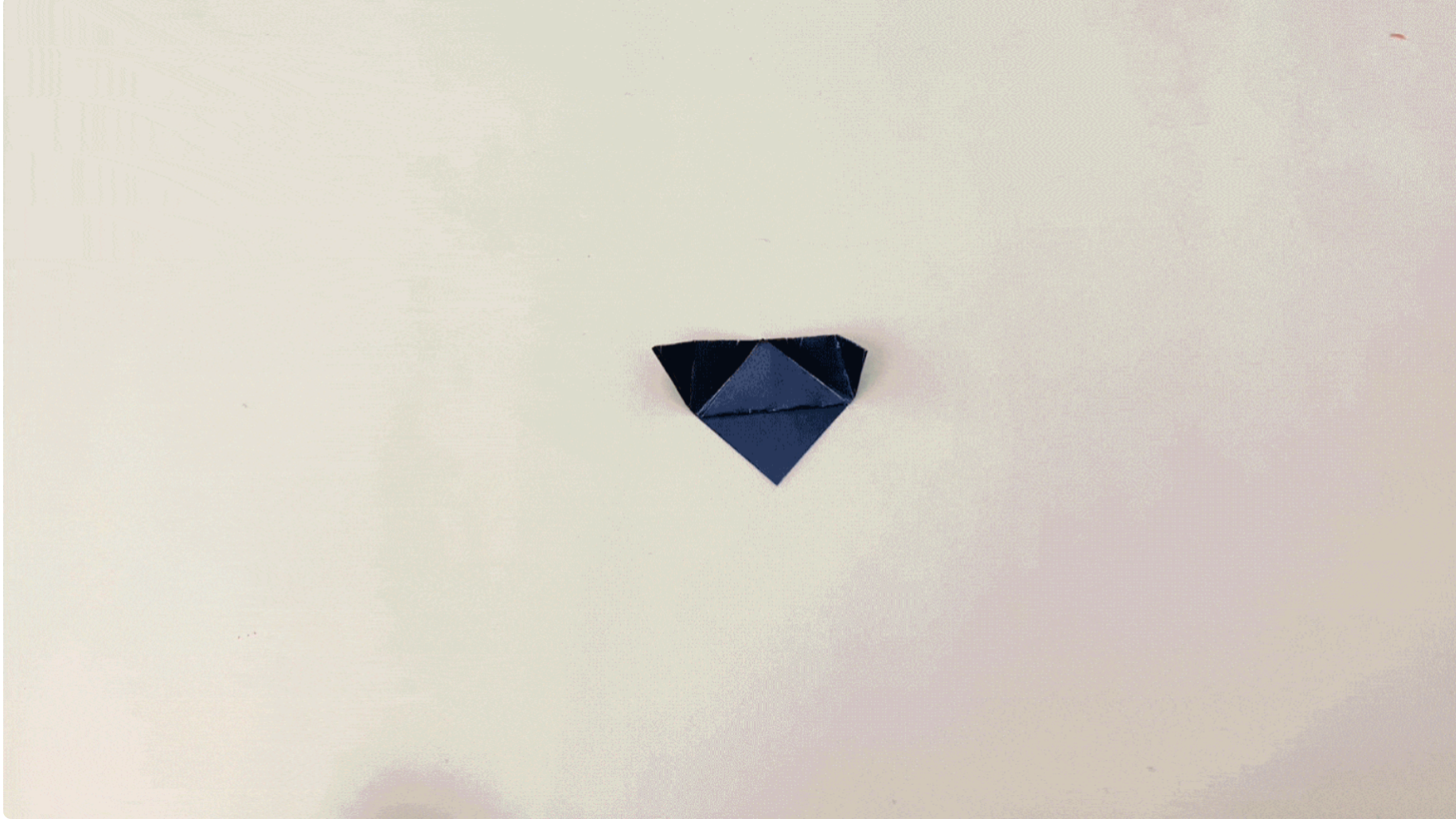
2. Fold the two end corners of the triangle up so they meet the middle corner of the triangle. This will form a square.



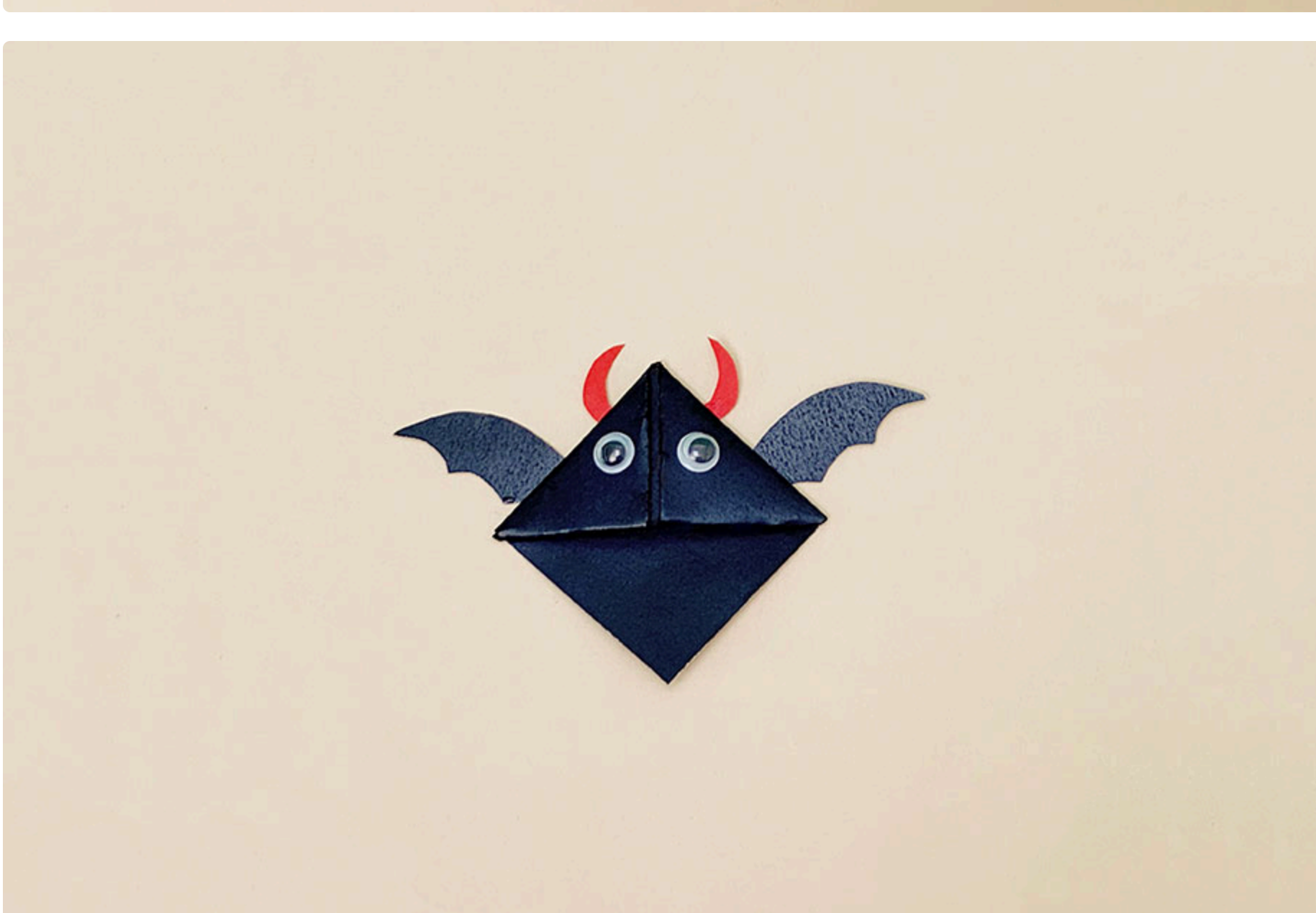
3. Unfold the previous step. There will be two crease lines. Take the top middle corner flap, align it with the crease lines, and fold it down.



4. Following the fold lines from step 2, fold the two long triangles on the sides and tuck them into the middle space.



5. Cut out eyes, ears, and wings from coloured paper and glue them onto the bookmark. Your bat bookmark is now complete!



6. Change the colour of the cardstock and use the same steps to create different beautiful bookmarks.



7. Final display
