
DIYs » Artistic Adventures » Quick Easy Craft Activities » Age 3 - 5 » Flapping Bat



This is a simple and enjoyable parent-child DIY project—creating a bat with flapping wings! With just paper, glue, and a few easy steps, you can make a paper bat dance through the air.

Materials Needed


Black card paper Drinking straw Pencil Scissors Yarn Ruler Hot glue gun Stick-on eyes



Step-by-step tutorial

Step 1

Draw a bat on the black card paper using a pencil.



Step 2Use scissors to cut out the bat along the pencil lines.



Step 3

Stick the eyes onto the bat's head.






Cut two pieces of yarn that are 10cm longer than your straw.



Step 5

Thread both pieces of yarn through the straw and apply hot glue to one end of the straw.



Step 6

As shown in the picture, glue the straw with hot glue to the middle of the bat's body.



Step 7

As illustrated, use hot glue to attach each piece of yarn to the bat's wings.



Step 8

Now, pull the two pieces of yarn at the bottom of the straw, and watch the bat's wings flap!
