Get Crafty! Make Your Own Christmas Tree!

Materials Needed:

Paint Palette Scissors Paint Cardboard Felt-Tip Pens Cotton Buds Screwdriver



Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Draw a Christmas tree on the cardboard.



2. Use a screwdriver to poke holes in the Christmas tree (parents can help with this step).



3. Dilute the paint to a watery consistency, and dip both ends of the cotton buds in the paint.



4. Use scissors to cut the cotton buds in half (parental assistance needed).



5. Insert the cotton buds one by one into the holes in the cardboard, and start decorating your Christmas tree!
