



Coin Ejection Game Table

This simple and fun educational game helps children develop hand-eye coordination, concentration, and reaction skills. Using a recycled Tinkerer box, you can create a coin ejection game table to challenge finger dexterity and skill.

Materials Needed

Cardboard box
Ruler
Pencil
Coloured pencils
Coins



Step-by-step tutorial

Step 1

Use a pencil to mark dots on the cardboard box, spacing them 5cm apart as shown.



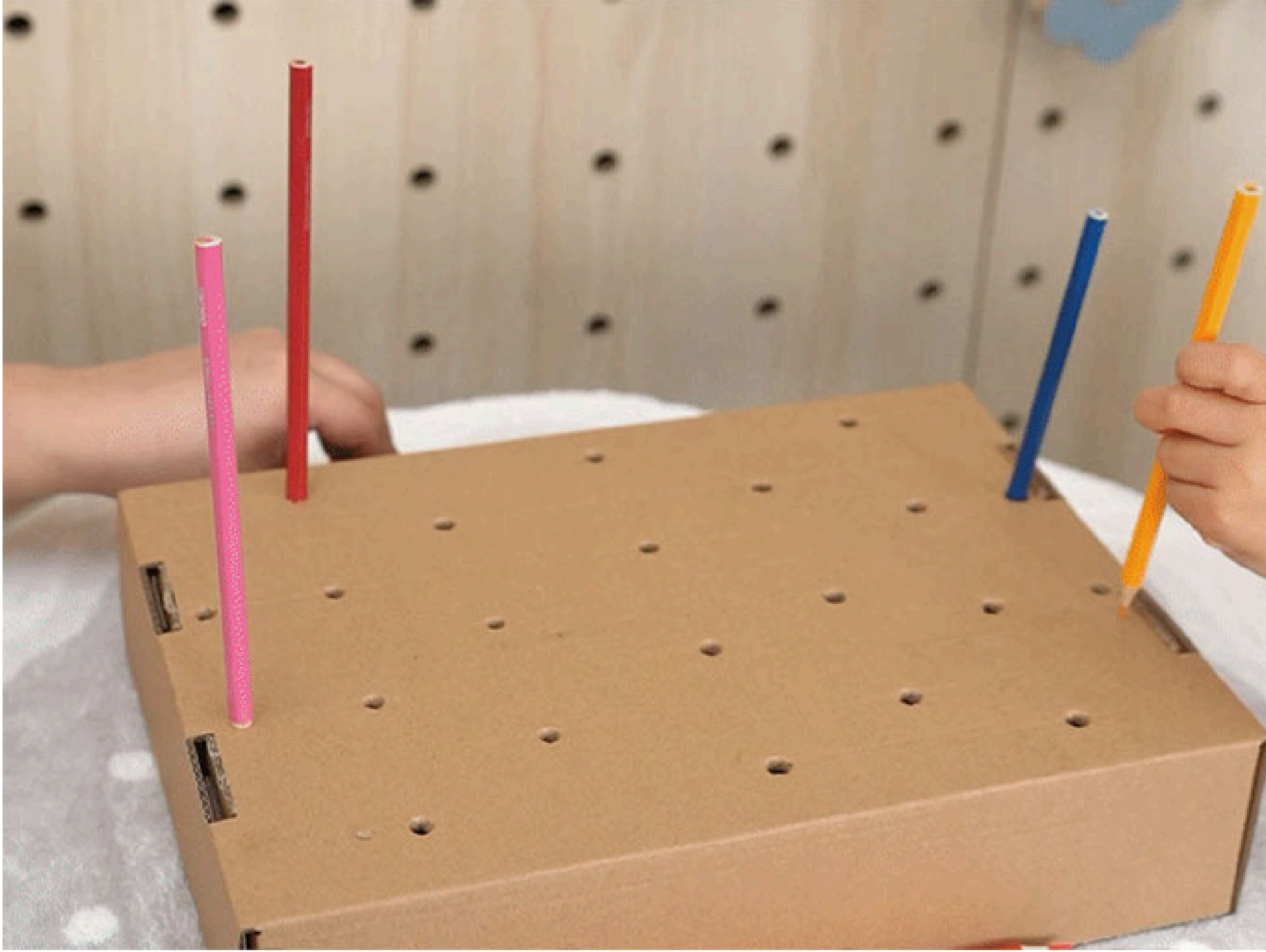
Step 2

Using the pencil, make holes at the marked points.



Step 3

Together with family or friends, insert coloured pencils into the holes.



Step 4

Place coins on the box and compete with your partner - the first player to flick their coin to their opponent's side wins!
