
Materials Needed:

A large container Bicarbonate of soda Vinegar Food colouring Washing-up liquid Small toys like eyeballs and spiders




Step-by-Step Instructions:


Pour a cup of bicarbonate of soda into the container and add a small amount of washing-up liquid.
Please place the container on a large tray, or you can move it outdoors for this operation. The following scenes might cause some mess.



2. Pour half a cup of white vinegar into a cup and add your preferred food colouring. If you want the colour to be more vibrant, you can add more colouring.



3. Place spiders, eyeballs, or other spooky small toys you can find at home into the container.



4. Pour the vinegar into the container. The mixture in the container will start to fizz and bubble up with a large amount of coloured foam. You can continue adding bicarbonate of soda and vinegar to create more foam. Observe the bubbling process with your family!



The Science Behind It:

The witch's magic comes from the chemical reaction between vinegar and bicarbonate of soda. When vinegar (containing acetic acid) and bicarbonate of soda (sodium bicarbonate) mix, they undergo an interesting acid-base reaction, producing carbon dioxide gas. This gas forms a large amount of foam in the liquid, giving a bubbling effect. Adding washing-up liquid makes the foam even richer.
